Bridge Builders hosts this free event to educate the public about the different cultures in Anchorage. Over 30 cultural booths are set up with displays from individual communities and staffed with cultural representatives to greet visitors and explain their customs, traditions, costumes and values. Many booths have activities such as calligraphy demonstrations, games, or origami (paper folding). Attendees are given a “passport” at the entrance that has an entry from each culture explaining customs and traditions; as visitors stop by each table, that culture’s passport page is stamped with a symbol from that culture. Ethnic entertainment is featured throughout the day, offering music and dance while people get to know their neighbors.

Event location: The Anchorage Museum at Rasmuson Center, 121 West 7th Avenue

- Everyone will have ONLY ONE 8-foot skirted table, in accordance with the Museum’s 2010 restrictions. Each ethnic table will have the name of the country on a sign.
- If you need an electrical outlet, please check this box:
You need to bring your own extension cord.
The museum will provide a roll of tape for taping the cord to the floor, if you do not have one.
- If you have other special needs, please let Bridge Builders know by February 12.
- **Please have a stamp representing your culture to stamp the passports.**

Set-up for the event:

- Set-up for the tables begins at 10:00 a.m.
- All tables must be set-up by 11:15 a.m. so everything is ready at 11:30 a.m. when the event is scheduled to begin.
- Parking is available in the parking garage; the garage entrance is located on W 7th Ave., just west of the main entrance to the Museum. There will be young volunteers to help carry your boxes.
